

The National Service Scheme (N.S.S)

The national service was launched by the government of India on 24 September 1969 on the occasion of the birth centenary of the father of the nation Mahatma Gandhi. It is a voluntary organization of youth especially college students working for the purpose of personality development of the youth of the country. The aim behind this is to develop the personality of the college students through social service and create national spirit in them.

The NSS unit of Arts & Science College Shivajinagar Gadhi, provides a platform to the students for social and national work and NSS helps to develop a sense of Participation in nation building in the minds of volunteers. Various activities are organized every year with the aim of inculcating idealism and creativity in the minds of the college youth. In order to create awareness among the people of rural areas about health, Sanitation and water conservation various social welfare activities are conducted by organizing special camps in the villages every year.

 - The Konark wheel in the symbol has eight bars which represent the 24 Hours of the day. Hence badge reminds we are to be in readiness for service of the nation round the clock i.e. for 24 hours.
 - The Red color in the badge indicated that the NSS volunteers are full of blood i.e. lively, active energetic and full of high spirit.
 - The Navy blue color indicates the cosmos of which the NSS is a tiny part, ready to contribute its share for the welfare of the mankind.
