Miscellaneous services are the main group of services in India and all over the world which has the main share in services exports and imports. It contains the following services: Software services, business services, financial services and communication services.


Table 1 provides data of exports of OCS services. In year 2004-05 software services value was US \$ 17700 million and showing posi-

tive trend it increased up to US \$ 74153 million. During 11 years software services value increased by US \$ 56453 million, its share show increasing trend it was 40.93% in 2004-05 and it increases year by year up to 48.05% in 2015-16, except 2010-11. Growth rate of software services show decreasing trend its growth rate was 27.68 % in 2004-05 and it decreasing year by year and growth rate remains 1.41% in 2015-16. Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) was 13.91% for study period.

Business services value was US \$ 5167 million in 2004-05 it increased up to US \$ 28994 million in 2015-16. During 11 years business services value increased by US \$ 23827 million, its share show increasing trend it was 11.95% in 2004-05 and it increases up to 18.79% in 2015-16, except some years. Growth rate of business services show decreasing trend its growth rate was 44.48 % in 2005-06 and it decreasing year by year and growth rate remains 1.97% in 2015-16. Some years it shows negative growth rate. Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) was 16.98% for study period. It is greater than software services CAGR.

Financial services value was US \$ 512 million in 2004-05 it increased up to US \$ 4944 million in 2015-16. During 11 years financial services value increased by US \$ 4432 million, its share show increasing trend it was 1.18% in 2004-05 and it increases up to 3.20% in 2015-16, it was more than 3.20% in some years. Growth rate of financial services show decreasing trend its growth rate was 57.65 % in 2005-06 and it decreasing year by year and growth rate remains 14.50% in 2015-16. Some years it shows negative growth rate. Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) was 22.89% for study period. It is greater than software services, business services and communication services CAGR.

Communication services value was US \$ 1384 million in 2004-05 it increased up to US \$ 2171million in 2015-16. During 11 years communication services value increased by US \$ 787 million, its share show decreasing trend it was 3.20% in 2004-05 and it decreases up to 1.41% in 2015-16. Growth rate of communication services show fluctuating trend its growth rate was 12.14 % in 2005-06 and growth rate remains 8.1% in 2015-16. Some years it shows negative growth rate also. Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) was 4.18% for study period. It is less than software services, business services and financial services CAGR.

1.5 Composition of India's Imports of Miscel**laneous Services:**

Table 2 provides data of imports of miscellaneous services. In year 2004-05 software services value was US \$ 800 million and showing positive trend it increased up to US \$ 2699

million. During 11 years software services value increased by US \$ 1899 million, its share show fluctuating trend it was 2.88% in 2004-05 and it was 3.19% in 2015-16. Growth rate of software services show decreasing trend its growth rate was 40.50 % in 2004-05 and it decreasing year by year and growth rate remains -0.33% in 2015-16. Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) was 11.70% for study period. It was greater than communication services CAGR and less than business services and financial services CAGR. 

In year 2004-05 business services value was US\$ 7318 million and showing positive trend it increased up to US \$ 31095 million. During 11 years business services value increased by US \$ 23777 million, its share show increasing trend it was 26.30% in 2004-05 and it increases year by year up to 36.74% in 2015-16, except some years. Growth rate of business services show increasing trend its growth rate was 5.56 % in

2005-06 and it was increasing some years and fluctuating some years thus growth rate reaches to 11.10% in 2015-16. Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) was 14.06% for study period. It was greater than software services, financial services and communication services CAGR.

Financial services value was US \$ 832 million in 2004-05 it increased up to US \$ 3135 million in 2015-16. During 11 years financial services value increased by US \$ 2303 million, its share show increasing trend it was 2.99% in 2004-05 and it increases up to 3.70% in 2015-16, its share was from 6% to 10% in some years. Growth rate of financial services show fluctuating trend its growth rate was 13.78 % in 2005-06 growth rate remains -14.19% in 2015-16. Some years it shows negative growth rate. Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) was 12.82% for study period. It is greater than software services, communication services and less than business services CAGR.

Communication services value was US \$ 738 million in 2004-05 it increased up to US \$ 1001 million in 2015-16. During 11 years communication services value increased by US \$ 263

million, its share show decreasing trend it was 2.65% in 2004-05 and it decreases up to 1.18% in 2015-16. Growth rate of communication services show fluctuating trend its growth rate was -155.36% in 2005-06 and growth rate -2.21% in 2015-16. Half years out of total period it shows positive growth rate. Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) was 2.81% for study period. It is less than software services, business services and financial services CAGR.

Conclusions:

Thus here researcher has studied the composition of India's miscellaneous services trade during 2004-05 to 2015-16. We found that in composition of exports of miscellaneous services, financial services CAGR is highest as compare to other services exports. Regarding share of exports of miscellaneous services, software services rank was first, second business services and third rank of financial services. Means regarding exports of miscellaneous services we found the contribution of financial services, business services and software services is more than communication services. Financial services CAGR is high in composition of imports of miscellaneous services, next to it business services and software services. Means regarding imports of miscellaneous services also we found the contribution of financial services, business services and software services is more than communication services
